PREQUALIFICATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF COMPUTERIZED ACCESS CONTROL GATES WITH CCTV IN LAGOS PORT COMPLEX, TIN CAN ISLAND PORT COMPLEX AND ONNE PORT COMPLEX

A. INTRODUCTION

The Nigerian Ports Authority intends to provide Integrated and Computerized Access Control Gates with CCTV and Biometrics Systems that will be compatible with the present day state-of-the-art Information Technology (IT) infrastructure in the following locations:

1	Lagos Port Complex, Apapa	1
2	Tin Can Island Port Complex	2
3	Onne Port Complex	3

The system shall be linked with NPA's existing Command, Control, Communication and Intelligence (C_3I) Centre in the headquarters and Security Operations rooms. The system shall support future networking protocols to all ports including the headquarters. The system shall also include inbuilt wireless services and cell integration for the main gates and terminal operators' gates.

Bidders are not allowed to bid for more than two (2) lots.

B. SCOPE OF SERVICES

The scope of works shall be and not limited to the provision and installation of CCTV and Biometric access gates with an operation centre with systems at the Security Operations room at each location with integration to NPA's existing Command, Control, Communication and Intelligence (C₃I) centre at headquarters, Marina.

C. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Tender Requirements (SOFT and HARD COPIES)

- 1. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CO2 and CO7.
- 2. Evidence of Company Tax Clearance Certificate and Audited Account for the last three (3) years (2014, 2015 & 2016), duly signed by ANAN/ICAN licensed Auditors.
- 3. Evidence of Current Pension Clearance Certificate from National Pension Commission (PENCOM).
- 4. Evidence of Current Compliance Certificate with Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Act No. 19 of 2011.
- 5. Evidence of Current registration on the National Data Base of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) or copy of interim Registration report (IRR) as evidence of compliance with the requirement.
- 6. Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorized by the bidder.
- 7. All bids must be accompanied with a sworn affidavit disclosing that they do not have any Director who has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating

- to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter.
- 8. All bidders must accompany every bid with an affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) or Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
- 9. Evidence of Three (3) similar projects (Security Access Control Management and Equipment Calibration) executed in the past five (5) years including letters of award, completion certificates etc.
- 10. Company profile to include names, qualifications and experience of key personnel including company and personnel registration with relevant professional bodies Computer Professional of Nigeria (CPN), COREN, etc. (attach certificates and evidence of experience).
- 11. Evidence of Financial Capability from a reputable bank/Letter of commitment.
- 12. All relevant information concerning contact, telephone (preferably GSM No.) and e-mail address of company representative.
- 13. For Joint Venture (JV)/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided.

Note: i. Failure to comply with items 1-8 above will lead to disqualification of the bid.

D. SUBMISSION OF PREQUALIFICATION DOCUMENT

The prequalification documents are to be submitted in duplicate bounded hard copies (One (1) soft and two (2) hard copies of each), paginated and arranged with dividers as indicated above. The prequalification documents should be submitted in sealed envelopes and addressed to the "SECRETARY TO THE TENDERS BOARD, NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY" and clearly marked "PREQUALIFICATION FOR THE INSTALLATION OF COMPUTERIZED ACCESS CONTROL GATES WITH CCTV" Specifying PUBLIC NOTICE NO: 4009 and LOT NO....... and dropped into the designated Tender Box located on the 1st floor Headquarters Building, 26/28, Marina Lagos not later than 11.00am on Monday, 3rd July, 2017.
