INVITATION TO TENDER FOR CIVIL ENGINEERING WORKS

A. INTRODUCTION

The Nigerian Ports Authority hereby invites reputable and competent companies to submit tenders for the under-listed projects:

Fencing of Government Secondary School at Onne Community, Eleme LGA, Rivers State (Span 640m, H = 2m) as Corporate Social Responsibility.	Lot 1
Construction of 202 Metres Concrete Road Pavement at Ele Community, Rivers State as Corporate Social Responsibility.	Lot 2
Comprehensive Renovation of Clinic Buildings at St. Joseph Hospital Akpabuyo, Cross River State (Demolition Works, Tiling Works, Plumbing, Pipe Fitting and Re-Roofing) as Corporate Social Responsibility.	Lot 3

Bidders are not allowed to bid for more than one (1) Lot.

B. SCOPE OF WORKS

Detailed Information on the scope of works is contained in the Standard Bidding Document (SBD) to be issued to interested Bidders.

C. TENDER REQUIREMENTS

Interested companies should submit bound bid documents duly signed, paginated, separated by dividers and arranged in the order outlined hereunder:

- 1. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CO2 and CO7.
- 2. Evidence of Company Tax Clearance Certificate and Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2014, 2015 & 2016), duly signed by ANAN/ICAN licensed Auditors.
- 3. Evidence of Current Pension Clearance Certificate from National Pension Commission (PENCOM).
- 4. Evidence of current Compliance Certificate with Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Act No. 19 of 2011.
- 5. Evidence of Current Compliance Certificate with the Employees Compensation Act which requires that all employers of labour must remit 1% of the total annual emolument of their workers to the Nigerian Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF).
- 6. Evidence of Current Certificate of registration on the National Data Base of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by the Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) or copy of interim Registration report (IRR) as evidence of compliance with the requirement.
- 7. Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorized by the bidder.

- 8. All bids must be accompanied with a sworn affidavit disclosing that they do not have any Director who has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter.
- 9. All bidders must accompany every bid with a sworn affidavit disclosing whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) or Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
- 10. Company profile to include names, qualifications and experience of key personnel (attach academic and professional certificates).
- 11. For Joint Venture (JV)/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (Items 1-10 are compulsory for the Lead JV partner).
- 12. Evidence of **Three (3)** similar projects executed in the past five (5) years including letters of awards, completion certificates, etc.
- 13. Evidence of Financial Capability from a reputable bank/Letter of commitment.
- 14. All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), contact address, telephone (preferably GSM No.), fax and e-mail address. The Letter Head Paper must bear the Name and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company/Firm at the bottom of the page.

D. COLLECTION OF TENDER DOCUMENT

Interested companies are to collect the Standard Bidding Document from the Office of the General Manager, Procurement, Room M.W.10, 1st Floor, Headquarters Building of Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA), 26/28 Marina – Lagos on provision of evidence of payment of non-refundable fee of **\#10,000.00** (Ten Thousand Naira) only for each LOT desired into REMITTA ACCOUNT OF NPA in any commercial bank. All tender sums from \#300Million and above should be submitted with a 2% bid bond of the tender price from a reputable bank and inserted in the financial bid.

Alternatively, you may pay online; go to www.remita.net; Click on "Pay a Federal Government Agency"; Type "Nigerian Ports Authority" in the MDA column; and select the option having "1000143"; For "Name of service/Purpose" Select "Tender Fees"; and conclude the process.

The Technical bids received before the deadline for submission will be opened **immediately** at the Conference room, 1 Joseph Street, off Marina, Lagos in the presence of bidders or their representatives, while the financial bids shall be kept unopened.
