PRE-QUALIFICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, COMMISSIONING AND SUPPLY OF THREE (3) NOS. POLLUTION CONTROL AND MONITORING BOATS – INTERNATIONAL COMPETITIVE BIDDING

#### **A. INTRODUCTION**

The Nigerian Ports Authority hereby invites reputable and competent companies to submit pre-qualification documents for the Construction, Commissioning and Supply of three (3) Nos. Pollution Control and Monitoring Boats to be used for oil/chemical spills and environmental protection surveillance within the Ports' jurisdiction.

## **B. SCOPE OF WORKS**

The scope of works includes but not limited to the following:

LOA: 15.5m including push knees; Hull: Aluminium; Beam: 5.1m; Propulsion: Twin screw, Caterpillar engines rated at 650 HP each; Speed: 26 Knots approx. (light); Bollard Pull: 8,618Kg (approx.); Fuel capacity: 3,218L; Oil Recovery Rate: 60m<sup>3</sup>/hour; Oil Collection Speed: 1 to 4 Knots; Integral Recovered Oil Tank: 10.3m<sup>3</sup>.

More information is contained in the Standard Bidding Document (SBD) to be issued to pre-qualified bidders.

#### C. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Interested companies should submit bound bid documents duly signed, paginated, separated by dividers and arranged in the order outlined hereunder:

#### **PREQUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Form CAC2 and CAC7.
- 2. Evidence of Company's Income Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016 & 2017) valid till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018 with cumulative minimum turnover of **\mathbb{H}1 Billion**.
- 3. Evidence of Company's Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2015, 2016 & 2017) duly signed by ANAN/ICAN licensed Auditors.
- 4. Evidence of Current Pension Clearance Certificate from National Pension Commission (PENCOM) valid till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018.
- 5. Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund (ITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31<sup>st</sup> December 2018.
- 6. Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (NSITF) Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December 2018.
- 7. Evidence of registration on the National Database of Federal Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration report (IRR) expiring on 1/1/2019 or valid Certificate issued by BPP.
- 8. Sworn Affidavit disclosing:
  - That the Company does not have any Director who has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter.
  - Whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) or Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present director, shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars.
  - That the Company is not in receivership, subject of any form of insolvency or bankruptcy proceeding or the subject of any form of winding up petition or proceedings.

- 9. All documents for submission must be transmitted with a Covering/Forwarding letter under the Company/Firm's Letter Head Paper bearing amongst others, the Registration Number (RC) as issued by the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC), contact address, telephone (preferably GSM No.), fax and e-mail address. The Letter Head Paper must bear the Names and Nationalities of the Directors of the Company/Firm at the bottom of the page.
- 10. Evidence of financial capability to execute the project by submission of reference letter from a reputable commercial bank indicating willingness to provide credit facility for the execution of the project when needed.
- 11. Evidence of Accreditation as an Original Equipment Manufacturer's (OEM's) Agent in Nigeria.
- 12. Evidence of capability to provide After Sales Maintenance Services after the Mandatory one (1) year Warranty Period.
- 13. Company profile to include names, qualification (copies of relevant academic and professional qualifications of such personnel must be attached) and experience of key personnel in Pollution Control and Monitoring Boats.
- 14. Verifiable documentary evidence of **Three (3)** similar boat projects executed in the last ten (10) years including letters of award, completion certificates, contract agreements.
- 15. For Joint Venture (JV)/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided. (Items 1-12 are compulsory for each national JV partner, while items 1, 2, and 8 are compulsory for each international JV partner as issued in home country).

# D. SUBMISSION OF PRE-QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

Interested bidders are to submit two (2) bound copies of pre-qualification documents, paginated and arranged with dividers as indicated above. The prequalification documents should be submitted in sealed envelopes and addressed to "SECRETARY TO THE TENDERS BOARD, NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY" and clearly marked "PRE-QUALIFICATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION, COMMISSIONING AND SUPPLY OF THREE (3) NOS.
