INVITATION FOR PRE - QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR "NATIONAL SHOPPING LIST" FOR SUPPLY OF AUTOMOTIVE GAS OIL (AGO) TO NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY

A. INTRODUCTION

The Nigerian Ports Authority (**NPA**) hereby invites reputable and competent contractors/suppliers to apply for Pre - qualification for "**National Shopping List**" **on** Supply of Automotive Gas Oil (AGO) to Nigerian Ports Authority at the underlisted locations for a period of Two (2) years.

Lot 1	LAGOS PORTS AREA
Lot 2	WARRI PORTS AREA
Lot 3	PORT HARCOURT/ONNE PORTS AREA
Lot 4	CALABAR PORT AREA

Note: Bidders are not allowed to bid for more than Two (2) Lots

B. SCOPE OF JOB

The scope of the Job is supply of AGO at the locations indicated above for electric power generating sets and other Ports facilities requiring same.

C. PRE - QUALIFICATION/ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Interested companies are required to submit Two (2) copies of their Pre-qualification documents duly signed, paginated, separated by dividers and arranged in the order specified hereunder:

- 1. Evidence of Certificate of Incorporation with the Corporate Affairs Commission (CAC) including Forms CAC2/Co2 and CAC7/Co7.
- 2. Evidence of Company's Tax Clearance Certificate for the last three (3) years (2016, 2017 & 2018) valid till 31st December 2019.
- 3. Evidence of Company Audited Accounts for the last three (3) years (2016, 2017 & 2018) duly signed by ANAN/ICAN licensed Auditors.
- 4. Evidence of current Pension Clearance Certificate (**PenCom**)valid till 31st December 2019.
- 5. Evidence of current Industrial Training Fund **(ITF)** Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December 2019.
- 6. Evidence of current Nigeria Social Insurance Trust Fund (**NSITF)** Compliance Certificate valid till 31st December 2019.
- 7. Evidence of registration on the National Data Base of Contractors, Consultants and Service Providers by submission of Interim Registration Report **(IRR)** expiring on 31/01/2020 or valid Certificate issued by Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP).
- 8. Sworn Affidavits disclosing:
 - a. That Company does not have any Director who has been convicted in any Country for any criminal offence relating to fraud or financial impropriety or criminal misrepresentation or falsification of facts relating to any matter.
 - b. Whether or not any officer of the relevant committees of the Nigerian Ports Authority (NPA) or Bureau of Public Procurement (BPP) is a former or present director,

shareholder or has any pecuniary interest in the bidder and confirm that all information presented in its bid are true and correct in all particulars

- c. That the Company is not in receivership, subject of any form of insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings or the subject of any form of winding up petition or proceedings.
- 9. Evidence of **Financial Capability** to execute the project by submission of reference letter from a reputable commercial bank <u>indicating willingness to provide credit facility</u> for the execution of the project when needed.
- 10. Verifiable documentary evidence of at least **three (3) similar supplies** executed in the past including Letters of Award, Contract Agreement, Job completion Certificates, Payments etc.
- 11. Company's profile to include names, qualifications (copies of relevant academic and professional qualifications of such personnel must be attached) and experience of key personnel (provide evidence of experience).
- 12. For Joint Venture/Partnership, Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) should be provided (CAC, Tax Clearance Certificate, Pension Compliance Certificate, ITF Compliance Certificate, NSITF Compliance Certificate, IRR & Sworn Affidavit are compulsory for each JV partner);
- 13. All documents for submission must be transmitted with a **Covering/Forwarding letter** under the Company/Firm's **Letter Head Paper** bearing amongst others, the **Registration No (RC)** as issued by CAC, contact address, Telephone (preferably GSM No) & email. The Letter Head Paper must bear the **Names & Nationalities of the Directors** of the Company at the bottom page.

Note: Failure to comply with items 1-13 above will lead to disqualification of the <u>Prequalification documents</u>

D. SUBMISSION OF PRE - QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

Prospective bidders are to submit Two (2) bound hard copies of **pre-qualification documents** in the order outlined above. The documents must be submitted in **SEALED ENVELOPE** and addressed to: "THE SECRETARY TO THE TENDERS BOARD, NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY" and clearly marked as "**INVITATION FOR PRE - QUALIFICATION OF CONTRACTORS FOR "NATIONAL SHOPPING LIST" ON SUPPLY OF AUTOMOTIVE GAS OIL (AGO) TO NIGERIAN PORTS AUTHORITY"** specifying PUBLIC NOTICE NO: 4101 (**SHOWING APPROPRIATE DESCRIPTION OF THE DESIRED LOT).** Furthermore, the reverse side of the sealed envelope should have the name and address of the bidder. Thereafter, drop the envelope in the designated Tender Box located on the 3rd floor of NPA Annex Building at 1, Joseph Street, off Marina Lagos not later than **11.00am** on **Wednesday, September 4, 2019.**

E. OPENING OF PRE – QUALIFICATION DOCUMENTS

The pre-qualification documents received before the deadline for submission will be publicly opened **immediately at 11.00am** on **Wednesday**, **September 4**, **2019** at the Conference room, 1 Joseph Street, off Marina, Lagos in the presence of the bidders or their representatives and any interested member of the public. Please, ensure that you sign the bid submission register at the **bid submission office**, as the Authority will not be held liable for misplaced or wrongly submitted bids. - 1. Bids must be in English Language and signed by an official authorized by the bidder
- 2. Late submission will be returned un-opened

- 4. The Authority is not bound to prequalify any bidder and reserves the right to cancel the Procurement Proceedings in the public interest without incurring any liabilities

to the bidders in accordance with the Provisions of Section 28 of the Public Procurement Act 2007.
