I am reliably informed that Dala Dry Port is in collaboration with a foremost Port Terminal Operator, SIFAX Shipping to promote seamless logistics management and coordination of the hinterland activities preparatory to eventual transportation of cargo through the maritime mode. This I must say is an uncommon demonstration of seriousness to take off.

Before I take my seat, let me congratulate the good people of Kano state, stakeholders and indeed all Nigerians on the birth of this noble cause.
